



OFFSHORE SAILING SCHOOL
JANUARY - MARCH 2010 - BEGINNERS PROGRAMME
Starting Saturday 30th of January 2010

1. THEORETICAL LESSONS

The theoretical lessons in English take place onboard, at the Marina of Thessaloniki, 2 hours prior to the practice lessons (every Saturday from 11:00 till 13:00). The theoretical lessons cover the following topics:

2. DAILY PRACTICE LESSONS

The practice lessons in English take place every Saturday 13:00 -19:00.
Our boats depart from the Marina of Thessalonica from berths 65-66-67-68-69

3. PRACTICE TRIP

At the end of the course you will go on a two-day offshore sailing trip, with overnight sailing, departing on **Saturday 27th of March 2010 at 08:00.**

4. EXAMS

On **Monday 29th of March 2010** at 18:00-20:00 (1st group) & 20:00-22:00 (2nd group) you will take written exams in order to obtain the sailing certificate. Please inform the school's secretary soon enough in which of the two groups you wish to participate.

5. SAILING CERTIFICATE

At the end of the course, provided you pass the exams, you will get the captain's certificate authorized by the Ministry of Sports and Education and the Ministry of Mercantile Marine. With this certificate you may charter a sailing boat up to 20 feet long.

6. PRICE

The price is 495,00 Euro per person and includes 130 hours of theoretical and practice lessons, with the 2-days practice trip, exams, certificate and VAT. The Annapolis book of seamanship (for the lessons in English) costs extra 50,00 Euro.
